How to apply?

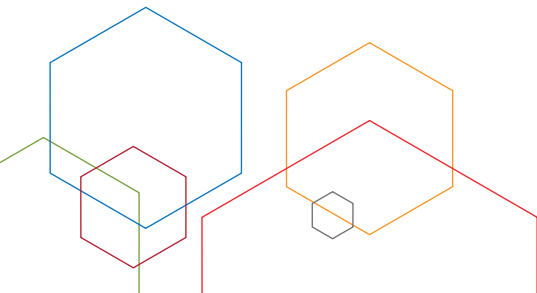
Please submit the ISSUP Award Nomination Form including reasons for and documentation to support your application to info@issup.net by April 15th, 2019.

In order to be considered for the award your nomination needs to include:

- Name of the initiative
- Name and information about organisation running the initiative including staff capacity and governance structure
- Duration of the initiative (start/end date)
- Location of the initiative
- Target group and numbers of individuals involved
- Brief outline description of the initiative:
 - Objectives/Mission
 - Outcomes
 - Evidence-based Initiative: Please give a brief description of how your initiative is informed by effective and evidence-based principles.

ISSUP is proud to celebrate and honour the work of individuals, organisations, projects and initiatives in the drug demand reduction field.

Who can be nominated?

The Services to Drug Demand Reduction Award honours individuals for their **outstanding contribution to drug demand reduction at the local, national or international level.**

Please note: Self-nominations will not be accepted.

Individuals can be nominated in three categories:

- **Lifetime Achievement:** Honours individuals who have achieved exceptional service and practiced leadership through sustained contributions to the drug demand reduction field in their lifetime. Individuals eligible for this award must have worked at least 20 years in drug demand reduction.
- **Excellence:** Recognises individuals for their unique and outstanding contributions to the drug demand reduction field. Individuals eligible for this award must have at least 8 years of work/volunteering experience in the drug demand reduction field and their contributions must be guided by ISSUP's Code of Ethics:www.issup.net/membership/code-of-ethics

- **Early Career:** Recognises individuals who are in the early stage of their career and have shown commitment and made outstanding contributions to the drug demand reduction field (e.g. through publications, research, policy work, volunteering, projects and other initiatives). Individuals eligible for this award must have less than 8 years of work/volunteering experience in the drug demand reduction field.

How to nominate individuals?

Any ISSUP Member can nominate an individual for this award.

Please send your nomination via email to info@issup.net by **April 15th, 2019.**

Please include the following in your email:

- Name and country of nominee
- Number of years in service in the drug demand reduction field of nominee
- Type of category you wish to nominate the person for:
Lifetime Achievement, Excellence, Early Career
- List and short description of contributions to the drug demand reduction field made by nominee (e.g. projects, programmes and other initiatives, publications, policy work at the local, national or international level). List and description should *not exceed 300 words.*
- Optional: Any supporting documents
(e.g. photos, academic papers, reports, local news coverage, etc.)

- Duration of the local initiative (start/end date)
- Location of the local initiative

- Brief outline description of the initiative including objectives/mission and outcomes
- Optional: Any supporting documents (e.g. photos, reports, evaluation forms, etc.)
